## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The 2002-2003 SAT scores released by the College Board reported that Georgia - for the second year in a row - had the lowest scores among other states. Georgia's average score was 984 out of a possible 1600. Most colleges and universities use the SAT score as part of the admissions criteria. Georgia is one of 23 states, plus Washington D.C., where a majority of the seniors take the SAT for college admissions.

Georgia had one of the highest SAT participation rates in the country, which also impacts the ranking. Out of the 23 states that administer the SAT (to more than 50 percent of their students), Georgia's average score ranked last.

In an effort to assist the State of Georgia improve the opportunity for college bound seniors to obtain admission to most colleges and universities, the NC A&T SU Atlanta Alumni Association is partnering with local and national businesses to launch Project Score. **Project Score** will provide SAT Prep scholarships to Metro Atlanta high school students.

The scholarship project will offer one-on-one sessions to serve students requiring the convenience and benefit of a personal teacher setting. In addition, the scholarship project will make available classroom sessions at participating high schools - for groups up to 25 students - for those who perform better in a group learning environment.

The goals of **Project Score** are as follows:

- Fund scholarships for up to 1000 students during the 2004/2005 school term
- Partner with local area high schools to promote ongoing awareness of the benefits of the Kaplan SAT Score preparation.
- Partner with local area high schools to secure optimal student participation
- Partner with Kaplan to offer provide the Kaplan SAT Score Prep program with score increase guarantees
- Annually report quantitative results for each participating school
